

Student Assistant Coaches (Junior Coaches):

- 1. Junior Coaches must be in 11th grade or 12th grade.
- 2. In order to be on the sidelines at any game, Junior Coaches must have a valid ID Badge for the season. ID badge must be visible at all times on the sidelines.
- 3. In order to qualify for an ID Badge Junior Coaches must:
 - Complete the USL online level 1 training (Fundamentals for Coaching Lacrosse – boys or girls) AND
 - Complete the PCA: Double Goal Coach: Coaching for Winning & Life Lessons (available on the USL website) AND
 - submit a photo via email to <u>registrar.ncpallax@gmail.com</u> for use on the i.d.
 - submit proof of age (birth certificate, passport, or report card) showing under 18 years of age and that they are in 11th or 12th grade.
- 4. Student Coaches must always work under the supervision of an authorized adult coach (background checked & trained). They may never be left to run a practice without an adult coach present and may not be on the sidelines unless an adult coach with an ID badge is present.
- 5. Student Coaches (under 18 years of age) do not participate in the mandatory annual background check.
- 6. Student Coaches must be under 18 years of age. At 18 years of age, they must comply with the adult coaching requirements
